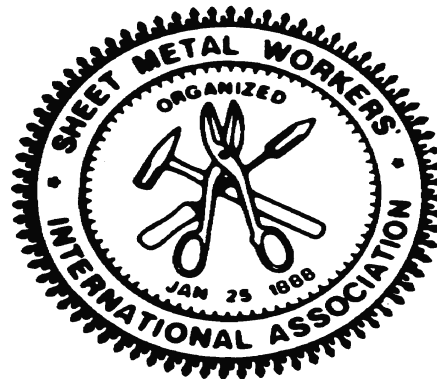

DELTA DENTAL NEWS:

If you are an active member (not retired) and are insured under the Delta Dental Insurance plan you are automatically eligible for the Rollover Max plan. That's right, if you have at least one cleaning per year, and have claims under the \$700.00 threshold of your \$1,500.00 annual maximum, \$500.00 will be rolled over to your annual maximum for the following year, and so on. Copayments for Prescription Drugs obtained at the Pharmacy:
(Limited to a 30-Day Supply)

Generic Drugs	\$12.00
Formulary Drugs	\$25.00
Non-Formulary Drugs	\$50.00

At Non-Participating Pharmacies:

Step 1: Pay the full cost of the prescription

Formulary Drugs	\$ 50.00
Non-Formulary Drugs	\$100.00

With the Mail Order Service:

- ✧ Your medications are dispensed through Costco Mail Order Services.
- ✧ Medications are shipped to you by standard delivery at no additional cost to you.
- ✧ You can track your prescriptions by calling Customer Service at (800) 607-6861.
